Jude is the brother of James who was slain with the sword ( ).  
As with the other writer he calls on believers to defend the faith.

Jude's book seems to address the Gnostics similar to John's epistles. But there were others who lived hedonistic lives who were not Gnostics per se.

James gives three illustrations to show that unfaithful and vile people meet their demise. It does not matter both angels and men cannot escape God's wrath upon them. He also shows these people of error as ignoring spiritual entities. He let's them know that fellowship with them is dangerous.

Jude says a number of accusations about them shameless shepherds, rainless clouds, doubly dead... It is unthinkable that people can live so ungodly yet be in the midst. He reminds them of the Apostles theme that many would come (false prophets).
